

Winter Brush Burning

a safer, cleaner burn

1. Gather/pile brush in an open area away from over-hanging branches.



2. Cover brush pile with a tarp. Keep the pile covered for at least two months before burning.



3. Choose a calm day (wind < 10km/h) with snow on the ground.



4. Place crumpled paper into the brush around base of pile.



5. Light the paper all around base of pile. Do not burn garbage or use accelerants.



Winter burning is permitted from November 1 - February 28, please check with your local fire department.

6. Enjoy a safer, cleaner burn with very little smoke.
